## OFFICIAL MINUTES MARCH 19, 2025 BOARD OF ZONING APPEALS MEETING

The Sykesville Board of Zoning Appeals (BZA) meeting was held on Wednesday, March 19, 2025. Chairperson McEvoy called the meeting to order at 1:16 P.M. in the Town House Conference Room.

Presentation – Board of Appeals Training
 Lynn Board, counsel with Levan and Ruff, gave a Board of Appeals training.

• Consider/Discuss/Act on proposed Board of Appeals Rules of Procedure

The Board of Appeals reviewed the draft rules of procedure. The BZA asked
for a removal of the language on page 3, until section 7 starting with the third
paragraph, "The following prehearing requirements shall apply to all
applications for a special exception, variance, or administrative review:..." and
continuing through the end of section 7c. The BZA asked for item A on page
four to be rewritten to be 20 days before a meeting. There was discussion
regarding a time limit for comments. It was determined to leave the time
limitations up to the discretion of the Chairperson of the BZA. There was a
discussion about swearing in those who give testimony during a public hearing.
The Town Clerk will be responsible for administering an oath to such people.
This is a change from what was proposed in the draft rules of procedure.

MOTION:

Board Member Mueller motioned to approve the Board of Zoning Appeals Rules of Procedure with the removal of section 7a-7c, the change to 20 days before a meeting on page four, and for the Town Clerk to be responsible for administering an oath for testimony. Chairperson McEvoy seconded the motion.

The motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business to come before the BZA, Chairperson McEvoy motioned, and Board Member Mueller seconded to adjourn the meeting at 2:41 P.M.
