Call to Order

Movie Location

Action Items

- Only adults should volunteer in the Snack Shack, no teens for now.
- Available to work the July 11 movie: Chris Sevick, Alex Ries, Bryan Troast, Nick Sheet and Eric Valenstein will have volunteers available to paint the spacing circles and line spacing for the Snack Shack.
- Due to the economic strain caused by Covid-19 SPARC will not ask for sponsors but will high light past sponsors in the slides before the movie.
- Alex will determine if there is enough time to do a movie poll on Facebook if not, she will choose a movie for July.
- September will be kept as a Rain Date.
