• # 20-16 Applied Wall Sign The applicant, Julie Della-Maria, was in attendance to discuss this application. She explained that the sign will be applied to the brick wall on the side of 7541 Main Street. It will be a welcome to Sykesville sign for people to take selfies in front of. The Downtown Sykesville Connection is also working on getting entrance signs for Sandosky Road and the bridge over the river at the south end of Main Street.

Commissioner Fogg noted that it would fit well with the other wayfinding signs in Town. There was discussion of the spacing and placement of the sign from the windows.

Commissioner Bederka motioned to approve application #2020-16 for an applied wall sign at 7541 Main Street with the sign staying a full brick course in from the windows and under the soldier course. Commissioner Johnston seconded the motion. All voted in favor.
