#### **MINUTES:**

February 22, 2022 – Commissioner Fogg motioned to approve the minutes as written. Commissioner McCullough seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

March 22, 2022 – Commissioner Fogg motioned to approve the minutes as written. Commissioner Johnston seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

#### **REVIEW OF APPLICATIONS:**

## • # 22-14 Roof Replacement

The applicant was in attendance to present. He explained the existing roof is more than 30 years old and is in bad shape. There is an existing chimney that he does not think it original that is also in disrepair. The bricks are falling off the chimney and have caused damage to the roof. Any damaged gutters and fascia would be replaced with the same color as the existing and in a non-reflective finish.

Commissioner Fogg motioned to approve application #2022-14 for 7508 Main Street as written, including the removal of a chimney and the replacement of any damaged gutters and fascia with the same color as existing and non-reflective finish as it is in compliance with the Guidelines on page 25. Commissioner Johnston seconded the motion. All voted in favor.

## • #22-15 Business signs

An agent for the applicant was present. He explained the hanging sign will replace the existing Dandelion Bakery sign. The new sign will be a little smaller than the current existing sign. The freestanding sign will be in the rear of the building in the MacElroy parking lot and will use a parking space that is already designated as parking for 7556 Main Street.

Commissioner Fogg motioned to approve application #2022-15 for 7556 Main Street as written as it is in compliance with the Guidelines on page 37. Commissioner

McCullough seconded the motion. All voted in favor.
